It does not matter whether we place the Vauni fireplace on the terrace to evoke the atmosphere of the nights by the camp firelight or whether we choose to make it an ornamental piece of our living room, and we enjoy the warmth of the flames on a cold day. Only our imagination puts a limit to its use. Vauni was created by its designers with the aim of providing an innovative and sustainable solution to replace traditional wood-burning fireplaces.

With regard to design, we can think about the wall-mounted Cupola and the sphere-shaped Globe models which can be placed anywhere, the latter is also available with low and high foot.

Vauni reached a milestone in 2023. Swedish designer, photographer, and colour expert Tekla Evelina Severin put a new dress on the organic fireplaces, and created a unique colour collection inspired by nature. So, besides the classic black and white we can also choose from five new designer colours. For the inserts around the burner, you can select between steel inserts in the same colour as the fireplace itself or 100% real mortar in Mystic Graphite and Mystic Sand colour designs.

Bioethanol operated fireplaces provide the heat in a modern and environmentally friendly way.

The burning process is completely clean during which only a small amount of carbon dioxide and water vapour forms, just like in exhaled air. With Vauni there is no need for a chimney, so it can be placed as a fireplace anywhere we like it, it can even be brought out on the terrace. The Cupola model can be easily installed on a wall of any kind of structure.





What is bioethanol?

Bioethanol is a type of alcohol with a high grade of purity which is produced almost in the same way as are the types of alcohol used in the food industry. Bioethanol made by modern production technologies is mostly made of reused plant waste, or plant crops grown for this purpose, for example corn. After production a difference is made between engine fuel and bioethanol used for fireplaces. Fireplaces operated with bioethanol can only be filled with ethanol used for fireplaces.

When creating NanoHouse Bioethanol we took the following aspects into account:

- to create an optimalized and perfect fireexperience for Vauni fireplaces
- to provide all this with a low demand for maintenance and cleaning
- and what is perhaps most important is to burden the environment with the smallest possible footprint during the course of production

NanoHouse Bioethanol comes from local rotational agricultural systems. This Southern Trans-Danubian Bioenergy Farm operates a sustainable system carbon neutrally without the use of fossil energy and it looks upon the produced waste types as sources of energy.

To sum it up, bioethanol is the type of an environment friendly fuel which is obtained from biologically renewing, natural and plant-based energy resources. It burns cleanly, with no dangerous particles getting in the air.
